The certifying officer is not at liberty to certify that the Government Servant requires a change from or to a particular locality or that he/she is not fit to proceed to a particular locality. Such certificates should only be given at the explicit desire of the administrative authority concerned to whom it should open to decide, when an application on such grounds has been made to him, whether the applicant should go before a Civil Surgeon/Staff Surgeon/Authorised Medical Attendant to decide the question of his/her fitness for service.
 2. No recommendation contained in this certificate shall be evidence of a claim to any leave not admissible to the Government Servant.
