# **Nutrition Awareness Program by M.Sc. students**

• A Nutrition awareness program was conducted by the I year students of M.Sc. (Applied Nutrition) for the school children aged 11-14 years studying at Govt. Girls High School, Lalapet (23<sup>rd</sup> March) and Model High School, Osmania University (30<sup>th</sup> March). The program was conducted to impart nutrition education to school children and to increase their awareness about eating right. The school going age is a very important period as it is a growth period and nutritional requirements are high and may be compromised.
