व्यथा का निवारण के लिए अभ्यावेदन की भाषाएं:

Languages to be used in the representation for redressal of grievance:

अनुच्छेद 350: किसी शिकायत के निवारण के लिए संघ या राज्य के किसी पदाधिकारी को, यथास्थिति, संघ में या राज्य में प्रयोग होने वाली किसी भाषा में अभ्यावेदन देने का प्रत्येक व्यक्ति को हक होगा.

Article 350: Every person shall be entitled to submit a representation for the redressal of any grievance to any officer or authority of the Union or a State in any of the languages used in the Union on in the State, as the case may be.
